Spring is coming! Happy Easter! Hopefully we'll see more sun in April than we have lately in March. Please use caution when walking outdoors. The ground is soft and uneven. Stay on the walkways if possible and use caution if you do walk on the grassy areas. Please refrain from walking in front of other residents' windows.

Spring heralds the arrival of severe weather season. Below are some tips on what to do in case the weather turns bad.

- Do not depend on the sirens to alert you to severe weather. They were designed only for outdoor use.
- If the weather turns bad, turn on your TV or radio to get information.
- If a watch is issued, it means conditions are favorable for severe weather to occur. If a warning is issued it means that you should take cover.
- Where should you take cover? If you can, take the stairs to the lowest level and get under the stairwell. **DO NOT TAKE THE ELEVATOR OR TAKE COVER IN THE COMMUNITY ROOM. DO NOT OPEN ANY WINDOWS.**
- If you are unable to take the stairs, take cover inside your bathroom and shut your door. If you are able, get inside the bathtub. Take a portable radio with you to follow the weather reports.
- You should have an emergency kit which includes a flashlight, batteries, first aid items, and water.

## **Maintenance Update:**

Thank you to all residents for your cooperation and flexibility during the annual inspection completed in March. The fire marshal will be doing random unit inspections in late April. Watch for a notice later this month with the date and time.



**Community Room Computer:** We hope everyone continues to enjoy the computer in the community room. As a reminder, residents need to have an account set up in order to use it.
