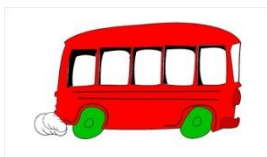

Hennepin County Resources:

There are different programs available through Hennepin County such as Elderly Waiver (EW) for people 65 years and older, Community Access for Disability Inclusion (CADI) for people with a mental or physical disability generally under 65 years old, Brain Injury Waiver (BI), and Developmental Disability Waiver (DD). These programs can assist with paying for in home services such as housekeeping, meals, medical equipment, personal care attendants, lifeline, ILS workers, nurse visits, and/or ARMHS workers, etc. for people who qualify based on income, assets, and level of care needed. The referral is made through Hennepin County Front Door Services. Once a referral is made it can take up to 3 months for a county social worker or nurse to do an assessment to determine eligibility. Individuals must have \$3,000.00 or less in assets to qualify, and if making over \$990 a month, there will be a waiver obligation one pays to receive services. There is also an Alternative Care Grant with the county that can help pay for services in the home and has higher income and asset limits. Please contact Paulla if you are interested in looking into these options further. **Please note that this is a general overview and specifics for each individual would be determined by the county.**
