## **Elevator Update:**

The company that will be completing the renovations on the elevator is tentatively scheduled to work on it starting Monday January 22<sup>nd</sup> with plans to have it operational by Monday February 5<sup>th</sup>. We will communicate any changes to this schedule as soon as we learn of them. **The elevator will be unavailable during this time period.** A meeting will be held in January to discuss further and address questions.

## **Community Room Kitchen:**

As a result of a HUD inspection, we are required to make the Community Room kitchen sink more accessible. Therefore, on Nov. 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, the old sink and cabinetry will be removed and replaced. The water in the kitchen will be turned off from Nov. 10<sup>th</sup> through the 15<sup>th</sup>. We are hopeful that the kitchen will remain visually pleasing and comfortable for all to use. We had no input in this matter and must comply with the HUD requirement. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, appreciate your cooperation and ask that you avoid the kitchen area during this construction.

## **Carpeting and Window Treatment Update:**

New carpeting will be installed on floors 2-5 sometime in early to mid November. Dates will be posted once finalized. New window treatments will be installed in the common areas on November 1<sup>st</sup>.



Daylight Savings time ends on Sunday, November 5th. Remember to **turn your clocks back one hour** on Saturday, November 4th, before you go to bed.



**Snow Plowing Guidelines:** We would like to remind residents that when there is a **snowfall of 2” or more**, the snow plow may come through and do an initial clearing of the main drives and visitor lot. Once the snow fall is over the plow will do its final clearing. This could occur the same day the snow ends or the following day. Once the visitor lot and main drives are cleared, a notice will be put up for residents to move their cars from the resident parking to the visitor lot. If the visitor lot is full we suggest you park at the church or shopping center temporarily. Please move your car back as soon as the resident lots are cleared. **SW Prime Updates:** SW Prime started offering **Saturday hours** on Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> and will operate from **8:00am to 6:00pm**. Saturday hours will include Southdale Mall as part of the service area, but on Saturdays only. For any resident who receives food benefits through Hennepin County and uses an EBT card, you are eligible for TAP (Transportation Assistance Program) and can use **SW Prime for \$1.00 per ride**. You would need to apply in person at the SouthWest Station. Please see Paula for more information on this program.

- With the new phone system, you will soon see “Front Door” on your phone when receiving a call from a visitor at the front entrance.
- You do not need to dial 9 for an outside line when using the new phone in the lobby. You will need to press the send button after dialing the number unless you use the area code.
