Snow Plowing Guidelines: We would like to remind residents that when there is a **snowfall of 2” or more**, the snow plow may come through and do an initial clearing of the main drives and visitor lot. Once it stops snowing the plow will do its final clearing. This could occur the same day the snow ends or the following day. Once the visitor lot and main drives are cleared, a notice will be put up for residents to move their cars from the resident parking lots to the visitor lot. If the visitor lot is full we suggest you park at the church or shopping center temporarily. Please move your car back as soon as the resident lots are cleared.
